

Robert Allen "Bob" McCann passed away at this home February 8, 2015. He was born in Baker, Oregon, July 3, 1947 to Robert Lorraine McCann & Patricia Nadine VanHooren and was later unofficially adopted by his parents Charley & Sharlet Fraters. Dad married his 2nd wife Kay Lorraine Lewis of Pocatello on December 5, 1972 and together they had one son Robert C in 1974. He had a son from a previous marriage Michael McCann (Pocatello) and a son from Kay's previous marriage Scott McCann (Pocatello). Bob was preceded in death by his parents, Charley in 1999 and Sharlet in 2002 and his wife, Kay in 2008.

Bob is survived by his sons, Robert C (Julie) of Pocatello, and Scott P of Pocatello; his granddaughters, Karen, Catherine, and Sarah McCann. He will be very much missed by his extended family and many friends.
